SUMMARY AND REQUIREMENTS

Port Orford police officers perform a wide variety of duties to promote public safety, security, prevent crime and enforce laws. A certified police officer performs law enforcement and crime prevention work including discovery, investigation, report preparation and patrol to enforce state, federal and local laws. This position oversees police program areas that may require additional specialized training.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

Equivalent to high school graduation and an ability to attain an Oregon basic police officer certification. Must be at least 21 years of age. Must be a U.S. citizen. Must not have been convicted of any crime punishable as a felony in any jurisdiction or a crime involving domestic violence (applicants with lesser criminal records will be evaluated on an individual basis). Must not have any military discharge less than honorable. Must possess a valid driver's license with an acceptable driving record. (Specifically, minimal moving violations in the past two years & no active or pending DMV suspensions at the time of the application).

APPLICATION MATERIALS

Application materials must be completed and received by city hall on or before the closing date. Electronic copies are accepted with a signature. Application materials can be downloaded from our website at www.portorford.org , or requested by mail by calling city hall at 541-366-4570.

SELECTION PROCESS

A city application form and cover letter will be used to select top candidates. Those selected for further consideration will be invited to an oral interview. Prior to hiring, the successful candidate must pass all phases of the examination process, including: oral and written exam, criminal background investigation, psychological test, physical and agility testing. Lateral candidates are encouraged to apply and they may be subject to an abbreviated process where the POST and ORPAT tests are bypassed.

NOTIFICATION

Applicants who are not selected will be notified by mail once the position has been filled.
