#### 1. Call to Order

Mayor Pogwizd called to order this special meeting of the Common Council on the sidewalk outside of City Hall to comply with governor restrictions due to COVID-19.

#### 2. Resolution 2020-09 – A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Port Orford, Oregon for the Purpose of Limiting Transmission of COVID-19.

Councilor Cox moves to adopt the resolution with modification stating “in effect until further resolution of the council” with councilor Burns as second. ***Motion carried 3-0.***

Discussion: Mayor Pogwizd requested an in-service date. Council agrees the resolution to be effective immediately.

Attorney Kudlac questions how the public will be informed. CA Richards states a copy of the county resolution, this resolution and a letter will go to all of the vacation rentals and all motels in town as well as the RV parks. The packets will be mailed out 04/02/2020.

The schools are an option; however, they are closed by mandate from Governor Brown and have to research to see if this includes the grounds.
